Attached is the Secondary Water Chemistry Monitoring Program for the Midland Plant as requested by Mr L S Rubenstein's letter to me dated August 1, 1979. This program addresses each of the six items as presented in this letter in detail comparable to that normally found in Technical Specifications and commits CPCo to the development of specific procedures to carry out this program.

The letter further states that the Secondary Water Chemistry Program will be referenced as a condition of the Midland Operating License. This raises several questions:

1. Will changes in the program require NRC approval?
2. Will changes in the detailed procedures required to implement the program require NRC approval?
3. Technical Specifications normally present limits for operation, actions required when limits are not met and the surveillance requirements to show that limits are not exceeded. Will changes to only those aspects of the detailed procedures or program require NRC approval?

Your response to these questions is needed prior to our implementation of this program. We are available to meet with the staff to discuss and resolve these questions, if necessary.
