

ORDER GRANTING EXTENSION OF TIME (August 13, 1979)

On August 7, 1979, the Intervenor State of California Department of Water Resources (DWR) filed a request for an extension of time to respond to the fifth set of interrogatories propounded to it by Applicant, Pacific Gas and Electric Company (PGSE). Good cause having been shown and no objections filed, the request is granted. DWR has up to and including September 6, 1979 to respond to PGSE's fifth set of interrogatories.

DWR is also granted an extension of time in which to move to compel further answers to the fourth set of interrogatories propounded by DWR to PG&E, if the parties cannot agree upon the information to be supplied.

It is so ordered.
