Oil leakage from a motor housing led to an investigation the showed a defect in the casting for the lower reservoir of shaft drive end bearing on motor 3AF-P2A. Visual inspection of three other similar motors shows a possible defect in North Anna Unit 4 motors 4AF-P2A and 4AF-P2B.

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The vendor has been notified and a representative is scheduled to provide on-site inspection to determine corrective action to be taken.
