Dear Mr. Kodner:

This is in response to your letter dated September 7, 1979, in which you requested, pursuant to the Freedom of Information Act, copies of all "supplemental" records and files as defined in and relative to matters contained in FOIA request number FOIA-79-264 submitted by Mr. Edward Gogol dated July 6, 1979, and in your petition titled: "PETITION FOR NRC TO INSTITUTE PROCEEDING TO SUSPEND AND/OR REVOKE LICENSE." Employing your definition of "supplemental", we determined that the documents you are seeking were acquired as NRC records during the time period July 6, 1979 through September 7, 1979, the date of your request.
