Dear Mr. O'Reilly:

This telegram is to confirm the conversation between Lee Spassard (Region I-NRC) and J.J. Colitz (TMI Unit 1 Superintendent) at 1400 hours on 23 July 1975.

The following report is submitted in accordance with paragraph 1.3.d (page 1-6) of the Technical Specifications.

On August 20, 1975 the Turbine Driven Emergency Feed Pump was run for Surveillance Testing. The pump operated successfully on steam supplied from A Steam Generator through MS V13A. When an attempt was made to test the pump on steam supplied from the B Steam Generator, the associated valve, MS V13B, opened in response to pressing the open pushbutton but closed when the open pushbutton was released.

Investigation revealed a failed pressure switch. The failed pressure switch would have prevented the valve opening on an automatic start signal.

The pressure switch was replaced and the Turbine Driven Feed Pump was successfully tested on steam supplied from the B Steam Generator within the 40 hour allowable time period.
