In the past few weeks we have received seven requests from your office for Departmental comments on nuclear generating stations, in accord with the requirements of the National Environmental Policy Act of 1969. 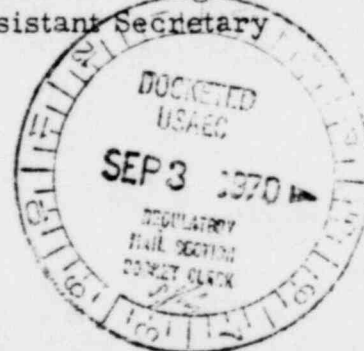
