This letter is in response to the three questions in I. E. Bulletin #79-19.

 How many low-level radioactive waste shipments did you make? Answer None.

(2) What was the quantity (Curies) of low-level radioactive waste shipped? Answer None.

(3) Did you generate liquid low-level radioactive waste? Answer None.

The only radioisotopes which our department has purchased in the last three years were license except quantities such as 32 P (10 uCi) and 131I (1.0 uCi).

We do have a license (#37-12881-01) for our Gammator--50 Model B containing a 137 Cesium sealed source purchased in 1968 from the Radiation Machine Corporation (50,000 R/hour).

A leak test is performed twice a year by the Isomedix Company. The removable activity is less than 5×10^{-3} microcuries of Cesium-137 for the Gammator--50.

If further information is required, we will be glad to supply it.
