

This refers to the inspection conducted by C. Stearns of this office on August 15, 1979 of activities authorized by NRC License No. 20-12924-02 and to the discussions of our findings held by C. Stearns with yourself and Mr. Van Dyk at the conclusion of the inspection.

The inspection was an examination of activities conducted under your license as they relate to radiation safety and to compliance with the Commission's rules and regulations and the conditions of your license. The inspection consisted of selective examinations of procedures and representative records, interviews with personnel, measurements made by the inspector, and observations by the inspector.

Our inspector also verified the steps you have taken to correct the items of noncompliance brought to your attention in a letter dated September 27, 1978. We have no further questions regarding your action at this time.

Within the scope of this inspection, no items of noncompliance were observed.
