As a follow-up to our letter of October 1, 1974, and in response to your letter of September 8, 1974, our schedule for the alarming of all exterior grade-level doors at our Three Mile Island Nuclear Station, Unit 1 (TMI-I) is as follows:

Rows include System Design (Jan 1975), Writing of Specifications (Feb 1975), Solicitation and Evaluation of Bid Proposals (Apr 1975), Procurement and Fabrication of Equipment (Aug 1975), Installation and Testing of Equipment (Oct 1975), Alarm System Operational and Incorporated into TMI-I Operations by a Revision to the Industrial Program (Oct 25, 1975).



Please understand that this schedule is tentative and is subject to delays (such as procurement of equipment) over which Met-Ed has little or no control. Should we encounter delays, we will so notify you and revise the schedule accordingly.



With regard to the continued protection of vital areas until installation and testing of the alarms has been completed, please recall that all exterior grade-level doors are being patrolled at least twice every eight-hour shift (see the enclosure to our letter of August 30, 1974), and we intend to continue this practice until the doors have all been alarmed.
