Your letter of August 22, 1969 to Metropolitan Edison Company requested a summary report on the programs that have been carried out in response to the recommendations by the Fish and Wildlife Service, along with copies of actual reports if available. In addition, you requested that Metropolitan Edison indicate any measures taken to comply with other recommendations of the Fish and Wildlife Service.

Metropolitan Edison indicated its intent to cooperate with interested governmental agencies in matters concerning radiological surveys and other concerns of the Fish and Wildlife Service in our letter to you dated July 25, 1969; Docket 50-320. Programs which are in keeping with the concerns of the Fish and Wildlife Service instituted by Metropolitan Edison are as follows:

- (a) Pre-operational Radiological Survey
 - Reference: (1) Docket 50-289, PSAR Supplement No. 1, dated October 2, 1967, Question 2.6.2
 - (2) Docket 50-320, PSAR Section 2.7
 - (3) Docket 50-320, Public Hearing Testimony Supplement to Summary Description dated October 1, 1969, page 15.
- (b) Biological Survey of the Susquehanna River in the Vicinity of York Haven, Pennsylvania.
 - Reference: (1) Docket 50-320, PSAR Section 2.7, page 2-18 Additional Survey (1), initiated August 7, 1967.

Results of the pre-operational radiological surveys accomplished to date were reported in Reference (a) (2) and (a) (3) listed above. Results of Reference (b) (1) are available for the year 1967 only and have not yet been reported for either 1968 or 1969. Study of thermal effects in the Susquehanna River has not been undertaken since the discharge temperatures of the effluent are near that of the receiving water.

Summary reports of the pre-operational radiological surveys and the biological surveys through the end of 1969 will be forwarded early in 1970. At present, as noted in Reference (a) (3) above, the environmental monitoring program at Three Mile Island is undergoing extensive review and modification. This comprehensive program, under development, will provide Metropolitan Edison with a more useful tool to monitor environmental conditions in the vicinity of the site.

We trust that the above information, along with the summary report which will follow, is responsive to your need.
