Gentlemen:

This refers to the inspection conducted by Mr. Folsom of this office on June 21-25, 1972 of construction activities authorized by AEC Construction Permits Nos. CPPR-40 and CPPR-66 and to the discussions of our findings held by Mr. Folsom with Mr. Wise of your staff at the conclusion of the inspection.

Areas examined during this inspection included the status of installed equipment and the implementation of the flood protection procedures during the emergency. Within these areas, the inspection consisted of selective examinations of procedures and representative records, interviews with plant personnel, and observations by our inspector.

No items of nonconformance were identified in the areas examined during this inspection.
