This refers to the inspection conducted by Mr. W. Tobin of this office on May 16-19, 1978, of activities authorized by NRC License Nos. DPR-50 and DPR-73, and to the discussions of our findings held by Mr. Tobin with members of your staff at the conclusion of the inspection.
