Gentlemen:

This refers to the inspection conducted by Mr. Folsom of this office on December 23, 1972 and January 3 - 5, 1973 at Middletown, Pennsylvania of activities authorized by AEC License Nos. CPPR-40 and CPPR-66 and to the discussions of our findings held by Mr. Folsom with Messrs. Stromberg and Avers at the conclusion of the inspection.

Areas examined during this inspection are described in the Regulatory Operations Inspection Report which is enclosed with this letter. Within these areas, the inspection consisted of selective examinations of procedures and representative records, interviews with personnel, and observations by the inspector.

Our inspector also examined those activities conducted under your license relating to the subjects covered in your letters to Mr. O'Reilly dated May 12 and September 11, 1972. We have no further questions regarding these matters.

Within the scope of this inspection, no violations or safety items were observed.

In accordance with Section 2.790 of the AEC's "Rules of Practice," Part 2, Title 10, Code of Federal Regulations, a copy of this letter and the enclosed inspection report will be placed in the AEC's Public Document Room. If this report contains any information that you (or your contractor) believe to be proprietary, it is necessary that you make a written application within 20 days to this office to withhold

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such information from public disclosure. Any such application must include a full statement of the reasons on the basis of which it is claimed that the information is proprietary, and should be prepared so that proprietary information identified in the application is contained in a separate part of the document. If we do not hear from you in this regard within the specified period, the report will be placed in the Public Document Room.
