SUBJECT: REED REPORT

The following responses are provided to the questions raised in your June 20, 1978 memorandum to R. S. Boyd on the same subject and related to the Black Fox project.

1. No, the Staff does not have a copy of the Reed Report now.
2. No, the Reed Report is not relied upon for any licensing action.
3. The report has not been formally designated "proprietary" by the Staff since it has never been submitted with a request for such a designation.
4. With respect to the Hendrie to Dingell letter of February 9, 1978, saying we would "request General Electric to release the Reed Report or at least the list of 27 safety issues. . .," General Electric has submitted the list of 27 safety issues and their status with a request that it be treated as proprietary. An NRR letter which agrees with the proprietary designation is in the concurrence chain.

In addition, I would advise that you check the Shoreham attorneys. I understand that the list is being provided to the Shoreham Board and intervenors.
