3 still has the affirmation before us. Can we affirm it with
4 the three present?

5 MR. HOYLE: We voted with the two who were not
6 present. We take a different position, favoring a review of
7 a portion of the case in this particular instance.

8 CHAIRMAN HENDRIE: Have they been willing to come
9 to an affirmation and affirm their previous negative vote?
10 And it stands as a three-two decision?

11 MR. HOYLE: They have.

12 CHAIRMAN HENDRIE: The record can simply note that
13 Commissioners Gilinsky and Bradford have indicated a
14 preference for review and that is their vote on this issue.
15 And the affirmation can take place with the votes of the
16 three commissioners who are now here.

17 COMMISSIONER AHEARNE: Your understanding is that
18 they will be supplying a statement?

19 MR. HOYLE: Yes. My understanding is that they
20 will be supplying a statement of their view later today.
21 Possibly tomorrow.

22 CHAIRMAN HENDRIE: Okay. I am willing to go ahead
23 with the vote on that basis. Of course, it is our custom
24 that if a commissioner asks for an item to be held, why,
25 we've respected that. We propose to do that here. So we

1 take the vote on the understanding that the other two
2 commissioners have been willing to have it go with the
3 majority vote this morning at the affirmation.

4 MR. HOYLE: That is my understanding,
5 Mr. Chairman.

6 CHAIRMAN HENDRIE: In that case, then, in the
7 matter of the Trojan review on ALAB-531, I would ask the
8 commissioners to affirm their votes.

9 (Show of hands.)

10 CHAIRMAN HENDRIE: That's alright. You affirmed
11 your previous vote. Okay.

12 MR. HOYLE: Right. Thank you, Mr. Chairman.
