


to Licensee's motion is due to be filed on October 17, 1979. In light of indication by the Intervenors that they will file a substantial statement opposing the motion, we believe it would be preferable if we had the benefit of their views before stating our own position. Accordingly, we request an extension of time until 10 days following our receipt of Intervenors' memorandum for filing of our response. In the event that we do not receive a memorandum from Intervenors by November 1, 1979, we would then file a response on that date.

We have reached Licensee's counsel and a representative of the jointly filing Intervenors. Neither objects to the request for an extension of time.
