In accordances with recommendations contained in the memorandum dated. October 18, 1979, on the above subject, we plan to comply with the requested actions by the following methods:

Part 2.a shall be accomplished by performing telephone and personal interviews with the appropriate individuals using the attached form.

Parts 2.b and 2.c shall be accomplished with the aid of the computer, RWP information, surveys and personal interviews as in Part 2.a.

please note, however, that as a result of record review, only those personnel whose exposure records indicate any sort of abnormality or incompleteness will have their exposure re-evaluated as stated above and not those individuals whose exposure records are normal and complete. In addition, those individuals identified as having been present in an area with abnormal conditions, such as the auxiliary building during the period of March 28 to June 30, 1979 shall also have their exposures re-evaluated.

Since it is estimated that more than 1000 personnel will be interviewed for the period of March 28-31, 1979 and at least 2000 exposure records will have to be evaluated for the period of April 1 to June 30, 1979, the above tasks will require the dedicated full time effort of six personnel. A supervisor with several years of experience in health physics and dosimetry will manage the task. He will be aided by two technicians with health physics experience and three clerks.

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Interviews and the associated reports should be completed by the end of January 1980. All changes to personnel exposures should be completed and verified in NRC Form 5, with corrected termination letters issued by the end of February, 1980.
