Dear Sir:

In accordance with the provisions of 10 CFR 50.54(p), the General Electric Company Vallecitos Nuclear Center (GE-VNC) submits herewith six (6) copies of revised pages to supersede pages of same name in reference 3, above.

The enclosed revised pages include minor changes as follows and as discussed in reference 6 above:

1. Reference to the Fuel Storage Area in Building 105 has been removed. The GETR does not foresee any further need for storage of SNM in this area. For ease in revision, certain sections have been retitled "(Reserved for future use)."
2. Appropriate changes in verbiage have been incorporated to reflect prior GE committals for plan revision as discussed in reference 4 and 5 and as the result of NRC rescission of requirements previously imposed on License SNM 960.

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

4. All revised pages indicate date of change. Specific changes are identifiable by a "bar/asterisk" which appears on those pages (figures excepted).


