Enclosed please find an application from the U.S. Department of Energy for a license to export uranium metal enriched to 45% and 19.75% uranium-235 to NUKEM, West Germany and Petten, Netherlands in support of the Reduced Enrichment Research and Test Reactor Program. DOE is also requesting a license to export a similar amount of material to CERCA, France and Petten, Netherlands in support of the same program (XSNM01616).
