Gentlemen:

Pursuant to the Staff's commitment to provide weekly reports on the status of resolution of open items and completion of the Staff's Safety Evaluation Report in the referenced proceeding, this constitutes such report for the week ending November 23, 1979.

During the past week, the Staff's structural review of the proposed modifications has continued to the extent that that review is independent of information sought in outstar 'ing Staff questions. Also, Licensee responses to Staff structural questions 9, 1' and 18 of October 2, 1979 were filed on November 21, 1979. These responses are being evaluated to determine whether they are complete and whether they satisfactorily resolve the open items to which they are addressed.

On November 21, 1979, the Licensee submitted its responses to Staff Plant Systems Branch questions 1, 2 and 4 of September 14, and questions 1, 2, 4, 5 and 6 of September 28, 1979. Responses to Plant Systems Branch question 3 of September 14 and questions 3 and 7 of September 28, 1979 have not yet been answered. The Plant Systems Branch reviewers are evaluating the responses that have been filed to determine whether they are complete and whether they satisfactorily resolve the open items with regard to the Plant Systems Branch areas of review of the proposed Control Building modifications to which the Staff questions were directed.
