
Dear Senator Culver:

Dear Mr. Romic:

This is in reply to your letter dated August 22, 1979, in which you requested, pursuant to the Freedom of Information Act, a copy of a list of accidents concerning nuclear power plants in the United States for the years 1949 through 1979. Your request asked for the plant site, cause, date and amount of radiation released into the surrounding area near the sites and/or to the workers in the plants.

This confirms that in a telephone conversation with you on September 12, 1979, Mr. Frank W. Karas of this office discussed with you the nature of your request so as to facilitate the search for documents which would contain information of interest to you.
