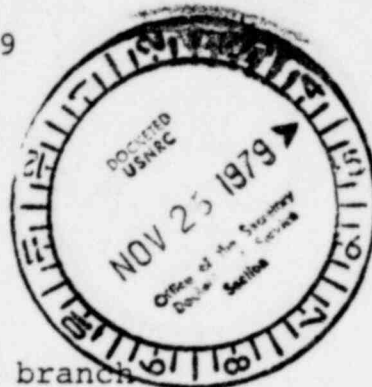

MAD wishes to participate as a "full participant" in the stages of the proceedings anticipated.


MAD is a community group based in and about Hattiesburg, Mississippi, including residents in and about the salt domes of South Mississippi being considered as a possible waste storage site.
