## Gentlemen:

This is in response to your letter dated October 5, 1979, which transmitted revised pages to your Fundamental Nuclear Material Control Plan.

We have determined that your proposed revisions are in accordance with the provisions of 10 CFR 70.32(c) and that they will not endanger the common defense and security and are otherwise in the public interest. Accordingly, License Condition 2.1 of Amendment MPP-2 to your License No. SNM-1227 is revised, effective immediately, to read as follows:

2.1 The licensee shall follow the Fundamental Nuclear Material Control Plan titled, "Nuclear Materials Safeguards Procedures Description for the Fuels Fabrication Plants", XN-12, Revision 5 dated February 1977; as amended according to the schedule of pages, XN-12, dated July 1979 which was transmitted with his letter dated October 5, 1979 from R. Nilson to J. G. Partlow; and as may be revised in accordance with the provisions of 10 CFR 70.32(c).

It has been established that the attachments to your letter dated October 5, 1979, contain information of a type specified in 10 CFR 2.790(d). Accordingly, pursuant to Section 2.790(d)(1) such information is deemed to be commercial or financial information within the meaning of 10 CFR 9.5(a)(4) and shall be subject to disclosure only in accordance with the provisions of 10 CFR 9.12.
