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RESPONSE TO I & E BULLETIN 79-24

Met-Ed has reviewed and identified safety related lines which are subjected to freezing temperatures. A procedure has been developed to inspect these lines to assure they are adequately protected during extemely cold weather. The inspection will determine:

- a. Operability of the heat tracing and whether the temperature control point is properly set,
- b. Whether the temperature sensor is located on the coldest portion of the line,
- c. Any heat trace damage (such as by leaking chemicals), and
- d. Missing or damaged insulation.

Discrepancies discovered during this inspection will be corrected, and NRC will be informed of any major deficiencies found.

It is anticipated that this inspection will be completed by November 30, 1979.

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
