We have, with great reluctance, decided to defer any further effort on the Tuba City project. This decision was reached because of these three factors:

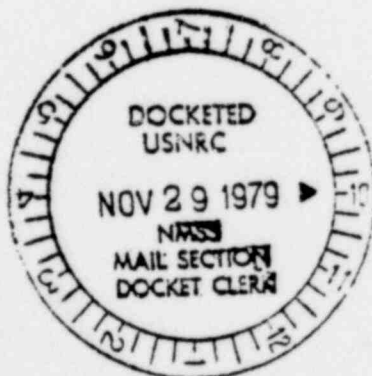
1. We do not have a clear understanding of what the regulatory cost, procedures, and time, would be.

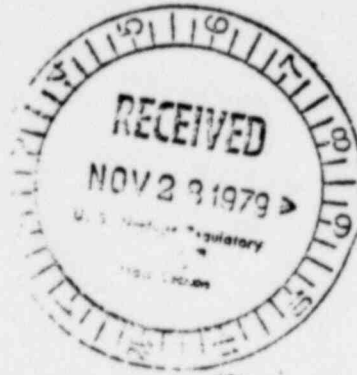

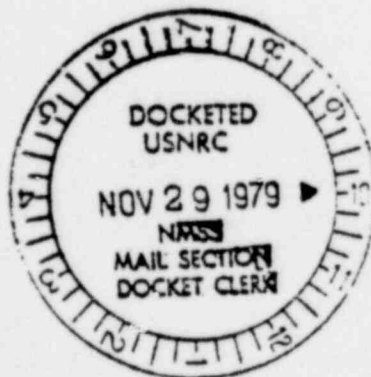
