Dear Mr. Potapovs:

In reference to your letter of November 7, 1979 regarding the inspection conducted at our facility on October 15-17, 1979 we offer the following:

- (1) The following steps have been taken regarding the identified deviations:
 - (a) a procedure has been written describing the method of controlling copies of the Topical Report
 - (b) all quality related records required to be signed and dated have been completed. Further, a procedure has been written for the control of quality assurance records
 - .
- (c) a meeting of the Task Committee Nuclear Quality Certification has been called for December 7, 1979 by the chairman for the following purpose (1) establish rules of operation, (2) the appointment of a two-man audit committee to audit the Director Quality Certification in compliance with the Topical Report
- (d) the internal audit report of ABSTECH has been transmitted to the AISC Director Quality Certification
- (2) The following steps have or will be taken by the AISC Director Quality Certification to prevent recurrence of the above: a complete and thorough check of the Topical Report will be made to assure complete compliance with the provisions thereof. The forthcoming audit of the Director Quality Certification by the Nuclear Quality Certification Task Committee two-man audit team is expected to verify the above corrective action.

(3) Corrective action and preventive measures will be completed on January 7, 1980.
