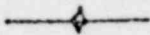

On motion made promptly, and in any event at or before the time specified in the subpoena for compliance, by the person to whom the subpoena is directed, and on notice to the party at whose instance the subpoena was issued, the

presiding officer or, if he is unavailable, the Commission may (1) quash or modify the subpoena if it is unreasonable or requires evidence not relevant to any matter in issue, or (2) condition denial of the motion on just and reasonable terms.
