PRELIMINARY NOTIFICATION OF SAFEGUARDS EVENT PNS-V-79/1A

This preliminary notification constitutes EARLY notice of events of POSSIBLE national security or public interest significance. The information presented is as initially received without verification or evaluation and is basically all that is known by IE staff as of this date.

Subject: CONTINUING LICENSEE INVESTIGATION INTO THE USE OF NARCOTICS BY INDIVIDUALS ASSOCIATED WITH THE TROJAN PLANT

This supplements Preliminary Notification No. PNS-V-79/1 issued 11/8/79. The licensee notified The Region V Office at 9:40 a.m. November 26, 1979 that their continuing investigation had resulted in the termination of an auxiliary operator for his uncooperative attitude regarding his alleged use of cocaine off-site. The investigation, thus far, has developed no conclusive evidence for use of narcotics on-site other than marijuana and amphetamines by certain members of the guard force who have subsequently been terminated.

Heightened media interest may result in press coverage of this PGE action. However, no press release is planned by either PGE or Region V.
