Gentlemen:

In reply to your referenced report, EG&G Inc., Electronic Components Division, has taken the following action to correct the infractions in Appendix A.

- Item 1 Concerning 10 CFR 20-103 "Exposure of individuals to concentrations of radioactive materials in restricted areas." Specifically, surveys of airborne radioactivity where Carbon 14 is used. Air samples will be taken in mid-October when the first pilot production lot will be assembled. Samples will be taken at monthly intervals thereafter or during production runs with our equipment recall system monitoring to insure proper survey performance in the future.
- Item 2 Concerning 10 CFR 20-103 "Exposure of individuals to concentration of radioactive material in restricted areas." Specifically, routine surveys are to be taken to determine presence of Ni 63 where production is handled. Routine monthly surveys of Ni 63 areas which were in process were completed August 15, 1979 and a second survey was completed in September with favorable results. The surveys will continue on the recall system and records will be available.

The programs for Item I and Item 2 which commenced August 15, 1979 will continue with a suspense document in our equipment recall system to insure
