Parma Community General Hospital symbol was created and adopted in 1973 to honor the community's observance of the hospital's tenth anniversary. The sturdy bars of the P and G signify strength and solidity; the C and G combined form an E for excellence; the bar of the G has a flaring line signifying a path for progress; and the interlocking body of the C and G is reminiscent of the caduceus, the medical profession symbol, and denotes the cooperation between the hospital and the community.
