Your letter of October 30, 1979 contains a Notice of Violation and requests our reply to include measures we have taken to correct the deficiency cited. Your citation (A) and our reply (B) follows:

- A. Contrary to 10 CFR 20.408 (b), as of September 27, 1979, you have failed to provide required reports within 90 days to the Commission, or the individuals involved, for nineteen individuals who terminated employment between January, 1976 and August, 1977.
- B. Please be advised that all terminated employees have been notified as required by part 20.408 (b) excepting that nineteen persons were notified a few days in excess of the 90 day limitation. All personnel involved with preparing exposure reports for terminated employees have been reinstructed regarding the procedure to accomplish this task in a timely manner. Full compliance will be achieved within 90 days after the next employee termination.
