THE INVESTIGATION WAS CONDUCTED BY THE NRC'S OFFICE OF INSPECTION AND ENFORCEMENT AND COMPLETED IN JANUARY 1978. THE REPORTS ARE IDENTIFIED BY TWO NUMBERS: #50-254/77/14 AND #50-265/77/14.

IF YOU REGARD ANY RECORDS IN THE LIST AS EXEMPT FROM REQUIRED DISCLOSURE UNDER THE ACT, I REQUEST THAT YOU EXERCISE YOUR DISCRETION AND DISCLOSE THEM NEVERTHELESS.

I FURTHER REQUEST THAT YOU DISCLOSE THE LISTED DOCUMENTS AS THEY BECOME AVAILABLE TO YOU, WITHOUT WAITING UNTIL ALL THE DOCUMENTS HAVE BEEN LOCATED.

I AM MAKING THIS REQUEST ON BEHALF OF THE DAILY DISPATCH, A NEWSPAPER OF GENERAL CIRCULATION BASED IN MOLINE, ILLINOIS. THE RECORDS DISCLOSED WILL BE USED IN PREPARATION OF NEWS STORIES FOR PUBLICATION.

I ALSO REQUEST THAT YOU WAIVE ALL FEES IN THE PUBLIC INTEREST BECAUSE DISCLOSURE WILL PRIMARILY BENEFIT THE PUBLIC, IF, HOWEVER, YOU DECLINE TO WAIVE FEES, I AM PREPARED TO PAY YOUR NORMAL SEARCH FEES AND COPYING COSTS, IF NECESSARY. I REQUEST THAT YOU NOTIFY ME IF YOUR SEARCH FEES WILL EXCEED \$20.

I LOOK FORWARD TO HEARING FROM YOU PROMPTLY.
