## Ι. SECY-79-430 - Connor FOIA Appeal - 79-A-15

- The Comission: 1.
  - by a vote of 5-0, approved the release of the following a. dccuments to Troy Connor, Counsel for Nuclear Engineering Company, Irc. in response to Mr. Connor's July 18, 1979 acceal from an initial FOIA decision (FOIA 79-213):
    - (1) Document 6 March 29, 1979 memorandum from the General Counsel to the Commissioners
    - Document 8C unsigned memorandum from the General (2) Counsel to the Commissioners, with attachments
    - (31 Document 8E - unsigned copy of Notice of Hearing
    - (4) Document 9 - draft Memorandum and Order
  - by a vote of 3-2, with Commissioners Gilinsky and Bradford ь. dissenting, denied Mr. Connor's appeal for the release of Documents 7, 3A, 83, 8D, 8F and 8G;
  - by a vote of 4-1, with Commissioner Gilinsky dissenting c. in part, \* cenied Mr. Connor's appeal for the release of Document #10. (OGC/SECY) (SECY Suspense: 10/12/79)
- The Commission requested that the proposed letter to Mr. 2. Conner be revised to reflect the views of individual Commissioners on this matter and that a copy of the signed letter to Mr. Connor and that copies of the released documents be placed in the Public Document Room. II. SECY-79-558 - Approval Under Section 145(b) of the Atomic Energy Act of 1954, as Amenaed, for Employment of Paul Fritz Langer as a Consultant to Commissioner Gilinsky and for Access to National Security Information and Restricted Data

Under the provisions of Section 145(b) of the Atomic Energy Act, as amended, the Commission, by a vote of 4-0,\* determined that permitting Paul Fritz Langer, who will be a consultant to Commissioner Gilinsky, access to National Security Information and Restricted Data is clearly consistent with the national interest and will not endanger the common defense and security.
