The Commission* was briefed on the status of the NRC EEO Program, and requested that:

1. staff encourage participation at meetings conducted by minority and female technical and professional organizations; (EEO)
2. staff encourage short-term appointments of professors from minority schools to the NRC, with a guaranteed return provision; in this connection, staff should consider use of letter notifications to appropriate department chairmen and an annual meeting with representatives of minority colleges and universities for the purpose of acquainting them with NRC's faculty programs. (EEO)

Commissioner Ahearne requested further information on the experience of the pilot job-sharing program carried out by the Office of Standards Development.
