- I. SECY-79-581 - Approval Under Section 145 (b) of the Atomic Energy Act of 1954, as Amended, for Employment of Stephen C. Whitfield as a Technical Intern to Commissioner Richard T. Kennedy, and for Access to Restricted Data (CONSENT CALENDAR ITEM)

The Commission, by a vote of 5-0:

1. Determined pursuant to Section 145(b) that the employment of Mr. Whitfield and Mr. Whitfield's access to Restricted Data is consistent with the National interest;
2. Granted Mr. Whitfield a "Q" access authorization pending the completion of an upgraded NRC access authorization. (SEC)

- II. SECY-79-598 - Proposed Amendment to 10 CFR Part 73.55 to Extend the Implementation Date for Certain Complementary & Alternative Measures for Protection Against the Insider Threat (CONSENT CALENDAR ITEM)

The Commission, by a vote of 4-0*:

1. Approved for publication in final form amendments to 10 CFR Part 73 extending the implementation time for pat-down searches, the two-man rule and additional compartmentalization to November 1, 1980. (SD) (SECY Suspend: 10/26/79)

The Commission requested:

2. That Wisconsin Electric Power Co., et al, be informed that action on their petition will be delayed; (SD) (SECY Suspend: 10/26/79)
3. That the appropriate Congressional Committees be notified of this action. (SD/OCA) (SECY Suspend: 10/25/79)
