



Suspension of 10 CFR 2.764 and Statement of Policy on Conduct
of Adjudicatory Proceedings (OGC)

The Commission, by a vote of 4-0,* approved the suspension, until further notice, of 10 CFR 2.764, which is its rule of practice on issuance of licenses after adjudicatory decisions. As provided in the Interim Statement on Policy and Procedures, 44 Fed. Reg. 58559 (October 10, 1979), this action will not affect non-adjudicatory proceedings or other adjudicatory matters including enforcement and license amendment proceedings, appellate decisions and partial initial decisions not authorizing issuance of new licenses or permits.

(Subsequently, the Secretary signed a Federal Register Notice in this matter on November 5, 1979.
