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### TRANSFER OF CONTROL PER INFORMATION APPENDIX G, NUREG-1556, VOL. 15

- The building and all assets pertaining to the nuclear medicine department (imaging equipment, measuring equipment, exercise equipment and sealed sources) have been purchased from Richard Hennig, D.O. of Michigan Cardiology, P.C. by Mustafa Mahmoud Hassan, M.D. of Heart Rhythm Clinic of Michigan. The new name of the practice is changing to Heart Rhythm Clinic of Michigan. Control of these assets will be given to Heart Rhythm Clinic of Michigan by Michigan Cardiology, P.C. on August 6, 2019.
- The new CEO will be Mustafa Mahmoud Hassan, M.D., authorized users will change to Hamid Sattar, M.D. and Tahir Mohamed, M.D. They are all currently authorized users on ARK Cardiovascular and Arrhythmia Center, PLC, license # 21-35069-01. The Radiation Safety Officer will remain Julie Dinkins, CNMT. Please find the enclosed Declaration of Authority.
- Mustafa Mahmoud Hassan, M.D has purchased and will obtain possession of the building, nuclear medicine camera, radioactive materials, sealed sources and radiation safety equipment on August 6, 2019. The location will remain the same, G-1386 S. Linden Road, Flint, MI 48532.
- 4. All required documents and records are currently kept in accordance with the NRC license condition. These include, but are not limited to, the annual calibration of survey instruments, semi-annual leak testing on non-exempt sealed radioactive sources, radiation monitoring and personnel exposure monitoring reports. Radiation monitoring is performed on a daily basis for acceptable radiation levels and weekly for removable contamination. The last patient of Michigan Cardiology, P.C. will be performed on July 10, 2019. Patients will resume under Heart Rhythm Clinic of Michigan on August 6, 2019.
  - The areas of storage, preparation, handling, and administration of radioactive materials are surveyed daily for acceptable radiation levels and weekly for removable contamination. If contamination of these areas is detected during these daily or weekly surveys, decontamination is undertaken and completed at that time. We have enclosed a diagram of the department. Please notify us if you would like the daily surveys and weekly wipes from July 10, 2019 forwarded to you.
- 5. Due to the small quantities and short half-lives of the unsealed radioactive materials, which we use, we are exempt from showing financial assurance for decommissioning. We do not use any unsealed radioactive materials with a half-life greater than 60 days, we do not dispose of any radioactive material into the sewer, and there are no open inspection items.
- All parties involved with the transfer are aware and agree to the planned transfer of ownership. Please see the enclosed, signed agreement page.
