The attached report of a special, announced inspection of the subject facility on June 8-10, 1971, is forwarded for information. No items of noncompliance or safety significance were noted.

The inspection, performed by a team of inspectors, focused on the management of the facility radwaste systems as outlined in the communication from D. Pomeroy to CO Senior Reactor Inspectors titled, "Special Survey - Radioactive Effluents" dated May 13, 1971.

No major problem areas were noted. Several minor items were identified and discussed with the licensee. One unresolved matter involved the determination of halogen and particulate plateout and impaction effects in the gas sample delivery line to the stack gas sampling station.

Other items recommended to the licensee for further consideration are the confirmation of his assumptions involving activity contributions from the gland seal condenser and the testing of stack particulate filter seals following installation.

The licensee has provided us with results of special samples left at the site for analysis. The isotope analysis is in close agreement with the analysis provided us with the sample.
