2. Organization

Biometric Testing, Incorporated is bankrupt and in receivership. The premises are occupied by Clinical Concepts, Incorporated, which appears to consist of the same people and conduct the same business as Biometric Testing, Incorporated.

The receiver is S. LaLomia, of Fontanella, Shashaty, Harris & LaLomia, 140 Market Street, Patterson, New Jersey 07505

3. Receipt of Licensed Material

The persons listed above stated that no licensed material had been procured since 1975. Two or three studies performed in 1975 involved administration to humans of material tagged with carbon-14 and red-blood cells tagged with chromium-51. All material, including air expired by the subjects, was returned to the person who contracted for the study.

Contamination Survey

A detailed survey with an end-window G-M survey meter did not reveal any residual radioactive contamination. Subject living areas, the nursing station, sample collection areas and bathrooms were included in the survey.

5. Exit Interview

The results of the inspection were reviewed with Mr. Robillard at the conclusion of the inspection. The inspector indicated the results would be forwarded to the Materials Licensing Branch for their use in terminating Biometric Testing's license.
