Technical Services Related to Decrement Curve Testing a High-Power Electrical Testing Facility

On July 29, 2019, contract 31310019C0011 was awarded to the KEMA POWERTEST LLC. in, Chalfont, PA. The purpose of this firm fixed price contract is to perform studies, simulations, and validation to determine if a highpower testing facility is capable of replicating the decaying energy profile of a tripped plant generator from its prime mover. The period of performance of this contract is from August 1, 2019, through September 30, 2020. The total potential value over the life of the award is \$784,356.00.
