NOTICE OF RECEIPT OF APPLICATION FOR CONSTRUCTION PERMIT AND FACILITY LICENSE

Jersey Central Power & Light Company, Madison Avenue at Punch Bowl Road, Morristown, New Jersey, pursuant to Section 104(b) of the Atomic Energy Act of 1954, as amended, has filed an application and amendment, dated April 22, 1968 and May 22, 1968, respectively, for authorization to construct and operate a pressurized water nuclear reactor on the applicant's approximately 800-acre Oyster Creek site located in Lacey Township, Ocean County, New Jersey, approximately two miles south of the community of Forked River.

The proposed reactor, designated by the applicant as the Oyster Creek Nuclear Generating Station Unit No. 2, will be located adjacent to the existing Oyster Creek Nuclear Generating Station Unit No. 1. Unit No. 2 is designed for initial operation at approximately 2452 thermal megawatts with a net electrical output of approximately 810 megawatts.
