Conversation with Henry Myers

Late yesterday I called Dr. Myers, Special Consultant to the House Subcommittee on Energy and Environment, to advise him that copies of the transcripts of the Commission's closed meetings on Three Mile Island would soon be available.

During the course of the conversation, Dr. Myers strongly emphasized that the Subcommittee expected that all tapes on which the transcripts were based would be preserved. He mentioned a problem with "mysterious gaps"in the Gossick tapes. He warned about similar "gaps" in these tapes.

I assured him that to the best of my knowledge all of the tapes were being preserved and that the Commission was aware of Chairman Udall's request that all of these tapes be kept. Following the conversation, I spoke with Sam Chilk to advise him of its substance.
