Sub: On & Off-Site Emergency Monitoring Teams

Ref. Memo to L. Lawyer from A. Tsaggaris of 4/14/79, same site

1. Due to the recent increase in ¹³¹I source release term, I believe that we should reduce our Emergency Monitoring Teams from 4 to no more than 2. Essentially one on-site and one off-site.
2. We need one site boundary and one closest residence ¹³¹I charcoal air sample taken each hour in the center of the downwind plume. T.L. data is necessary to prove that we are not causing significant off-site exposure.
3. I essentially agree with Tsaggaris's recommendation $\beta\gamma$ measurement plan for two teams, not one.
4. We continue to need the helicopter for logistical support and charcoal sample relay to the γ Spec Trailer on South Island.
