Time at Site

The inspector arrived at Three Mile Island Unit 2 on April 13, 1979 at 7:30 a.m. and continued up through May 15, 1979. During this period, the inspector had a total of 237 hours on site.

Summary of Activities

The objective of being on site was to perform surveillance of construction activities (welding, nondestructive examinations, etc.) for the following modifications:

- . Auxiliary Building Emergency Liquid Cleanup System
- . Fuel Pool Waste Storage System
- . Steam Generator B Cooldown (Water Solid)
- . Standby Reactor Control Pressure System
- . Auxiliary Building Off-Gas System
- . Backup decay heat removal system
