SUBJECT: Confirmation of Concurrence

This letter confirms our telephone conversation on July 2, 1979, in which we concurred in your planned schedule for returning your Hatch 2 reactor to service. This concurrence is based on our review of the results of your investigation and your planned retesting program.

We understand that the results of your investigation and the Hatch 2 retesting program will be factored into the Hatch 1 retesting program for the High Pressure Coolant Injection and Reactor Core Isolation Cooling Systems. We also understand that procedural changes resulting from your investigation will be reviewed for similar applications on other safety related systems. As appropriate, these procedural improvements will be incorporated in a timely manner for both units.
