DOCKETS 50-266 and 50-301 MANAGEMENT AND TECHNICAL RESOURCES POINT BEACH NUCLEAR PLANT

Your letter dated June 29, 1979 requested that we provide certain information that describes the capability of the management and technical staffs at Wisconsin Electric Power Company to react to an accident of the Three Mile Island type.

You have requested that we provide the information by July 30, 1979. We are gathering the required information from throughout our management, nuclear operations, engineering, communications, and logistic support staffs. In order to complete compilation of these data and to put this information into the format you have specified, however, we will require additional time to respond. We trust an extension of modest duration will not seriously impact your review activities.

We have also received Mr. Haass' letter of July 24 which specifies that 45 copies of this information be provided. It is our intention to request proprietary treatment for the information contained in our submittal since providing detailed information regarding human resources at Wisconsin Electric could be utilized to our disadvntage by personnel placement services and others. We, therefore, intend to provide only one copy of the requested information.
