PROGRAM SCOPE								
This was an unannounced, routine inspection of a temporary job site-only portable gauge licensee based out of Bolingbrook, IL. This inspection was performed through telephone interviews with the RSO and requested documentation provided via email. The licensee previously stored and dispatched portable gauges out of a location in Novi, Michigan, but removed all gauges from this location in 2016 and have not used gauges in NRC jurisdiction since.								
PERFORMANCE OBSERVATIONS The inspector interviewed the RSO with respect to the use, security, and transportation of their portable gauge while they were used and stored in NRC jurisdiction, as well as with respect to emergency procedures and the RSO's periodic review of the content and implementation of the licensee's radiation safety program. The inspector also reviewed a selection of records including usage logs, leak tests, gauge user training, and dosimetry reports. Through these interviews and record reviews, the inspector determined that the RSO was knowledgeable of NRC requirements for portable gauge use. Because the licensee had not used any gauges in NRC jurisdiction in the past few years, the inspector discussed the licensee's plans for future use of portable gauges under their NRC license with the RSO. No violations of NRC requirements were identified as a result of this inspection.
