This is in reference to the application dated July 8, 2019 requesting to amend Nuclear Regulatory Commission License No. 45-25221-01MD. In order to continue our review, we need the following additional information:

1. With respect to your request to add Dr. Mersed Kremic, Pharm.D as an Authorized Nuclear Pharmacist to your license, please address the following:
  - a. You provided documentation to show Dr. Kremic's registration in Missouri. Please provide documentation to show his registration in West Virginia. Alternatively, you may confirm that Dr. Kremic will only be working in Missouri.
  - b. Please provide a statement signed by Dr. Kremic that he alone completed all on-line courses that were presented for his structured educational program through the Nuclear Education Online as part of the University of Arkansas Health Sciences and University of New Mexico Health Sciences. Alternatively, you can provide information from Nuclear Education Online that indicates how they verify that the person who signed up for the program is the one that actually completed the program.
  - c. The Form 313A(ANP) submitted listed a time period for Dr. Kremic's classroom and laboratory training that coincided with his supervised practical experience, which is not permitted as per NUREG 1556, Vol 13. Please submit additional hours for his supervised practical experience that differs from the classroom and laboratory training which was previously submitted.

We will continue our review upon receipt of the requested information. Please reply within 30 days of the date of this email.
