In accordance with the guidance provided in NUREG-1021, "Operator Licensing Examination Standards for Power Reactors" (Revision 11), ES-501, "Initial Post-Examination Activities" Section C.1, the following materials are submitted in support of the Perry Nuclear Power Plant written operator license examination conducted on February 22, 2019:

No examination administration or post-examination review comments were made by the facility licensee and the applicants after the written examination and operating tests (ES-402).

The post examination performance analysis identified potential areas of weakness. Seven questions on the Reactor Operator Exam (RO-27, RO-28, RO-44, RO-60, RO-70, RO-71 and RO-73) and no questions on the Senior Reactor Operator Exam were missed by 50 percent or more of the applicants. This condition was entered into the Corrective Action Program under Condition Report 2019-01707 for further analysis.
