Gentlemen:

This refers to your letter of January 27, 1981, in response to the Notice of Violation and Proposed Imposition of Civil Penalties sent to you with our letter of January 16, 1981. Our January 16th letter concerned violations found during our investigation conducted on September 16-19, 1980, of activities authorized by NRC License No. 47-11883-01.

After careful consideration of your responses, we have concluded for the reasons given in the enclosed Order and attached Appendix A that, with the exception of Items F and H, the violations occurred as set out in the Notice of Violation, and that civil penalties should be imposed as proposed in the Notice of Proposed Imposition of Civil Penalties. After consideration of your response to Item F, the NRC has withdrawn the violation and its proposed civil penalty and after consideration of your response to Item H, that item is mitigated from \$200 to \$100. With respect to Item H, the licensee should submit plans for maintaining the quarterly inspection records as required by 10 CFR 34.28(b). Those plans should be submitted no later than 25 days from the date of the enclosed Order. We will review your records of required field examinations during our next inspection of your licensed program. Accordingly, we hereby serve the enclosed Order on Nondestructive Inspection Service, Inc. imposing civil penalties in the cumulative amount of Four Thousand Seven Hundred Dollars. In imposing this civil penalty, your statements regarding training of your employees were considered. Although such training was apparently conducted, it is necessary for you to place appropriate emphasis on following up of such training so as to assure compliance with NRC requirements.

We plan to continue unannounced inspections of your licensed activities. The results of these inspections, including implementation of corrective actions described in your letter, will be considered in determining whether any further enforcement action is appropriate.
